

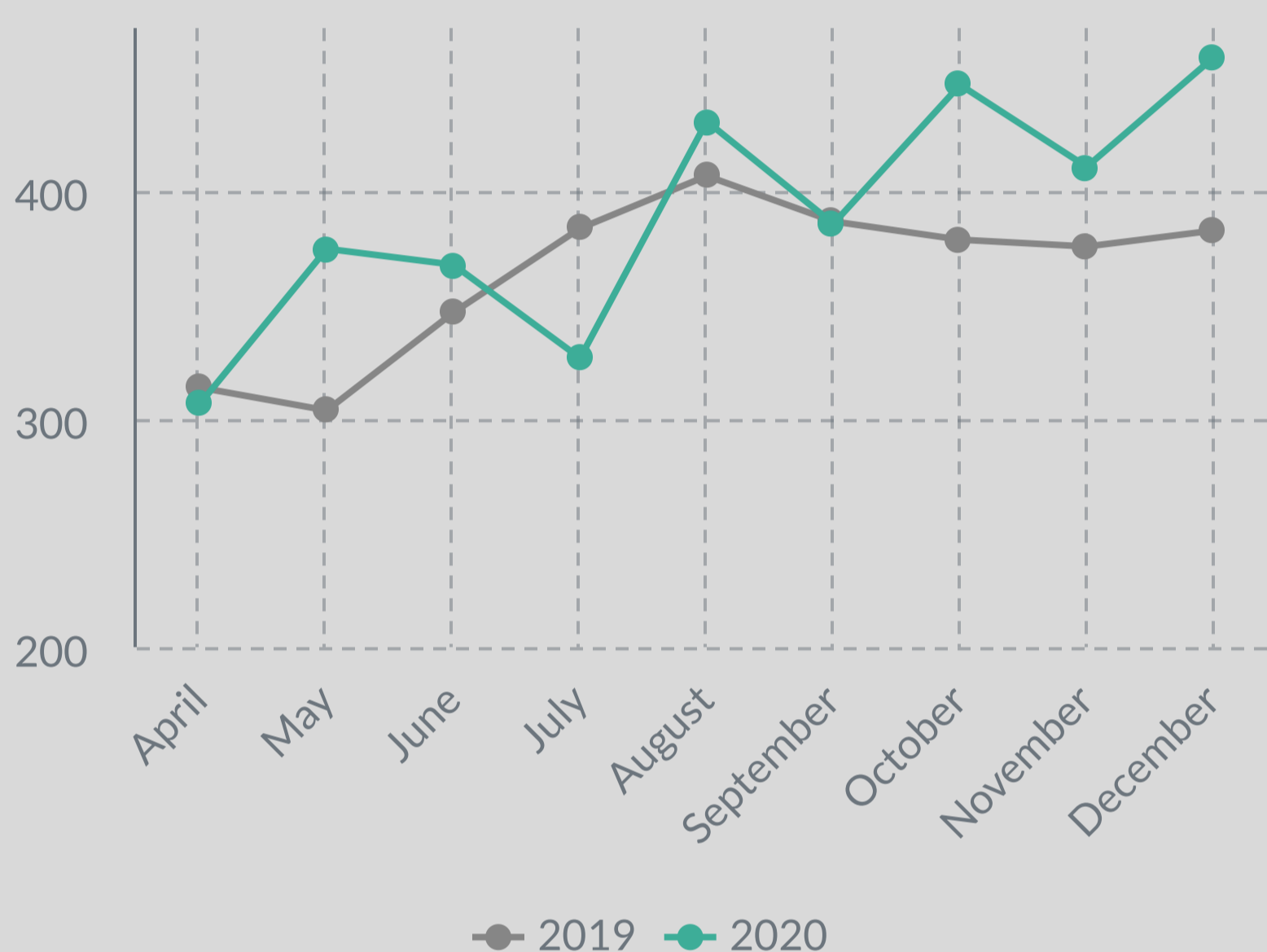

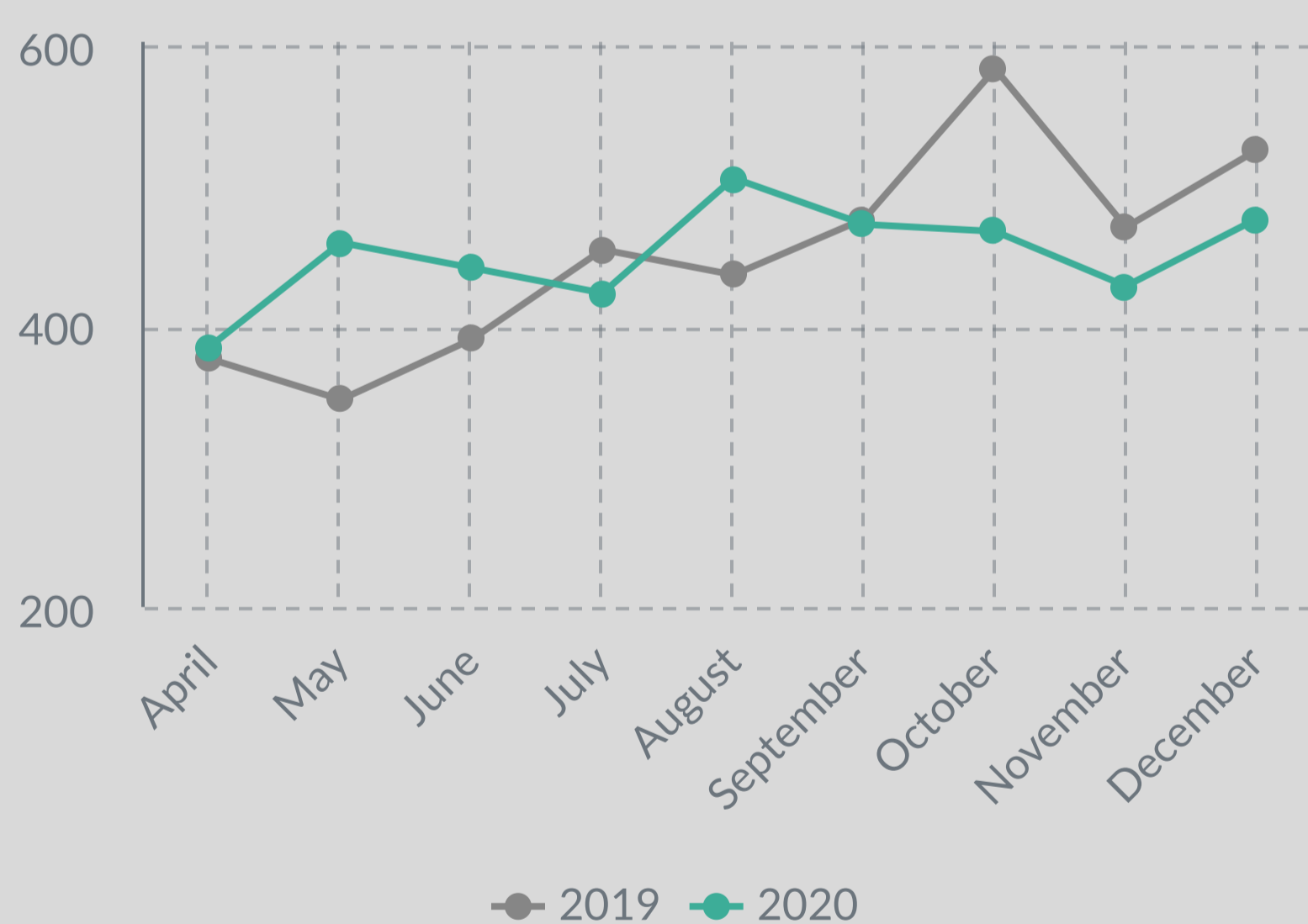
## Victim-survivors



Between 1 October and 31 December 2020, the overall number of incidents involving an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander victim-survivors increased 15.7%, compared to the same time period in 2019.

The number of victim-survivors aged under 18 increased 12.7% and the number of victim-survivors aged 55 and over decreased 8.4%.

## Primary aggressors



Between 1 October and 31 December 2020, the overall number of primary aggressors increased 15.1%.

The number of male primary aggressors increased 13%, while the number of female primary aggressors increased by 20.5%.
